## <u>Master of Studies in Applied Criminology</u>, <u>Penology and Management</u>

The course fee for students commencing Year One in 2019 will be £10,000

The fee will include tuition, college fees, accommodation, breakfast and one formal dinner per week. Rooms are normally made available from the Sunday evening prior to the course and need to be vacated by 9am the final Friday morning in each residential block. Rooms are held over the middle weekend in each block. Other meals are not included. The residential elements are compulsory and it is not permitted to graduate if these conditions have not been met. A certain amount of pre-course reading material is also provided as well as access to the Cambridge University Library and its dependent libraries. If delegates wish to hire bicycles for the duration of their stay, the Course Administrator will help organise this.
